

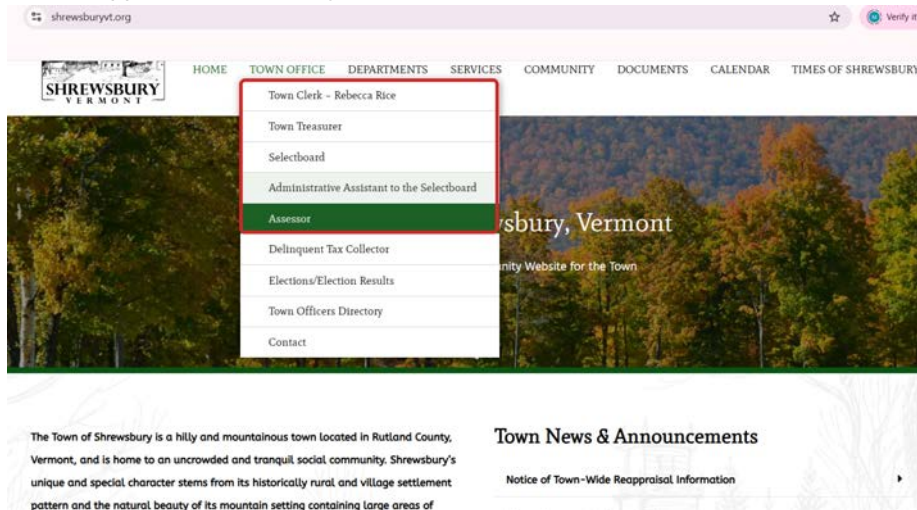
How to Get Your Property Record Card Online

Town of Shrewsbury, Vermont

Shrewsbury Property Record Cards are now available online. The Assessor page on the Town website is the permanent place to access property maps and cards - during the reappraisal and after it is complete.

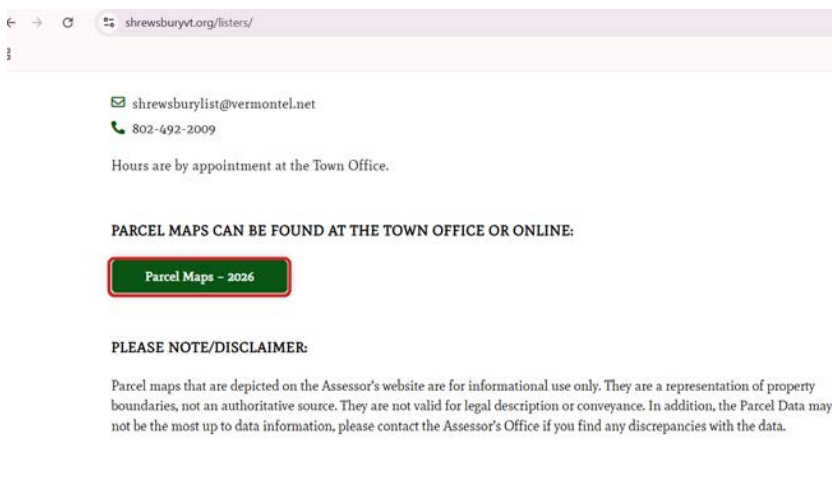
1 Go to the Assessor page

Go to shrewsburyvt.org. Under TOWN OFFICE, select Assessor. Reappraisal Information is also available from the Town website while the current town-wide reappraisal is underway.



2 Click Parcel Maps - 2026

On the Assessor page, click the green Parcel Maps - 2026 button. This opens Shrewsbury's AxisGIS property maps.

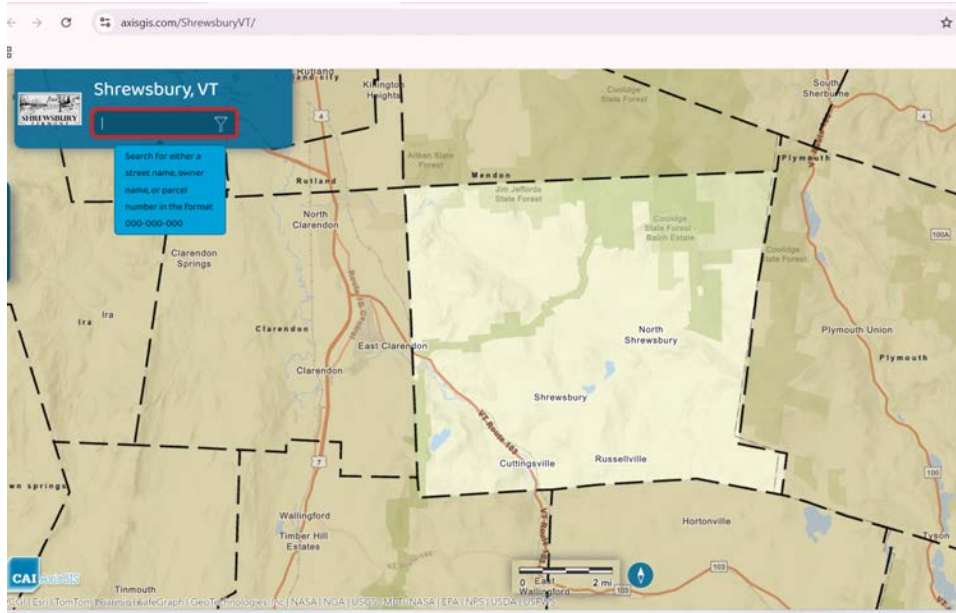

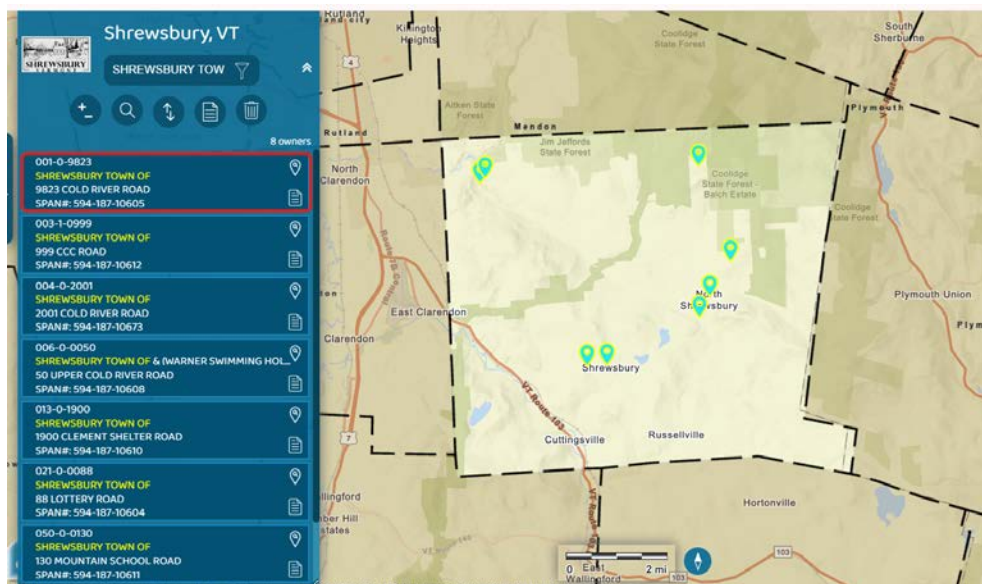
3 Search for your property

Enter a street name, owner name, or parcel number in the search box. Matching properties will appear as you type.



4 Select your property

Find your property in the results and click it. The listing shows the parcel number, owner name, property address, and SPAN.

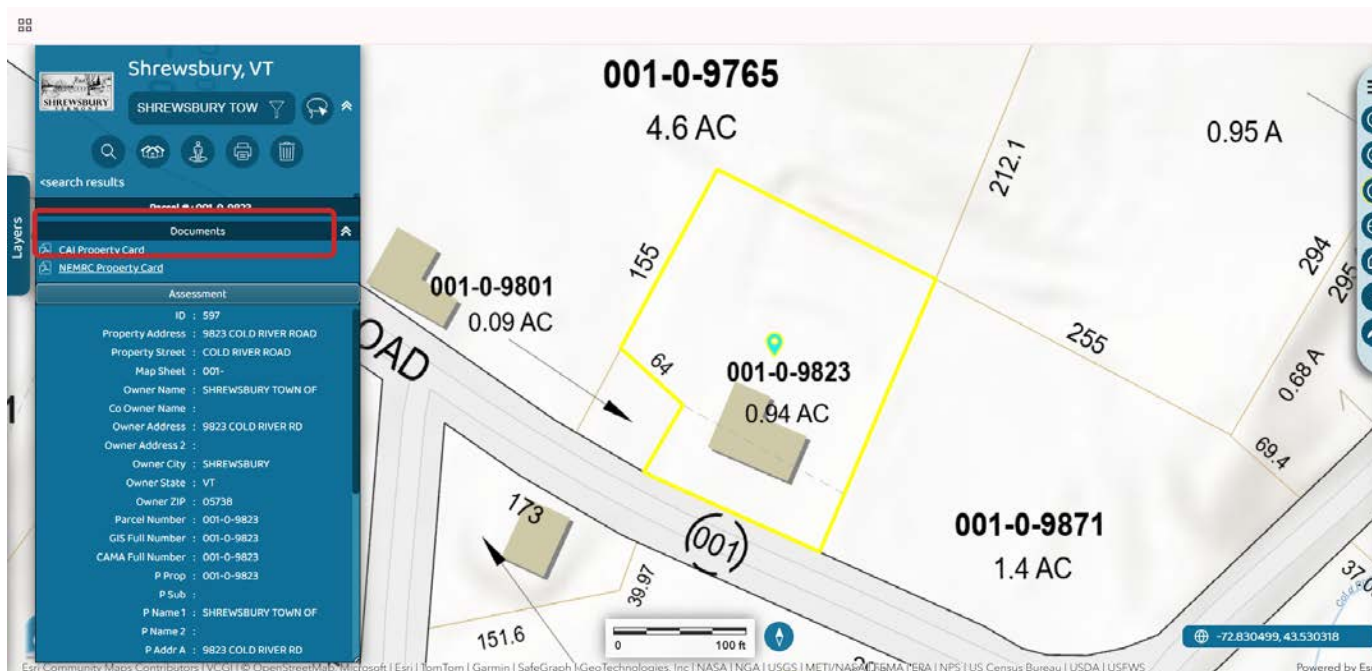

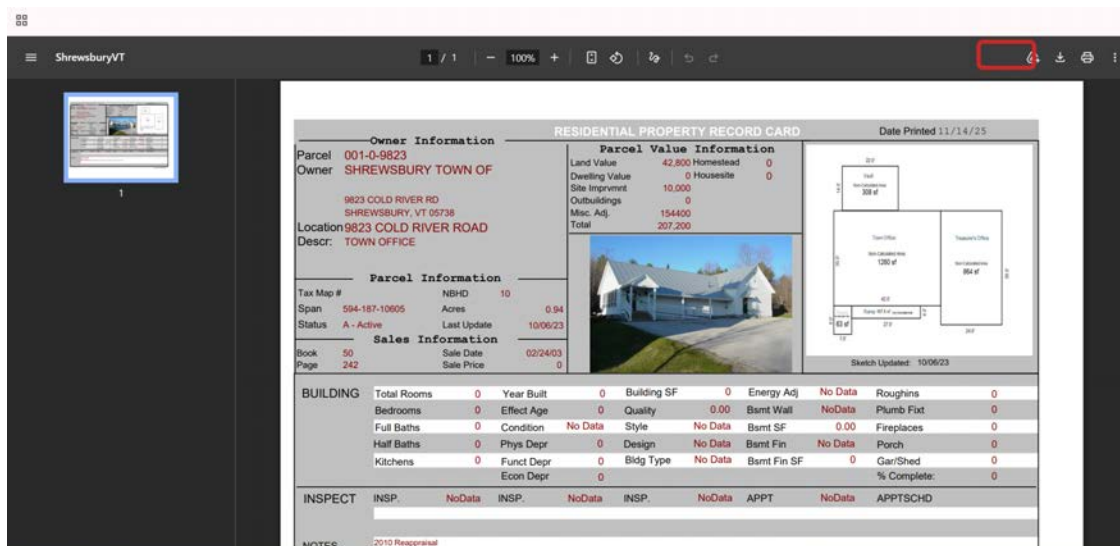
5 Open the Property Record Card

When the property opens, look under Documents on the left side of the screen and click NEMRC Property Card.



6 View, print, or save

The Property Record Card opens as a PDF. Use the icons in the upper-right corner of the PDF viewer to download or print a copy.

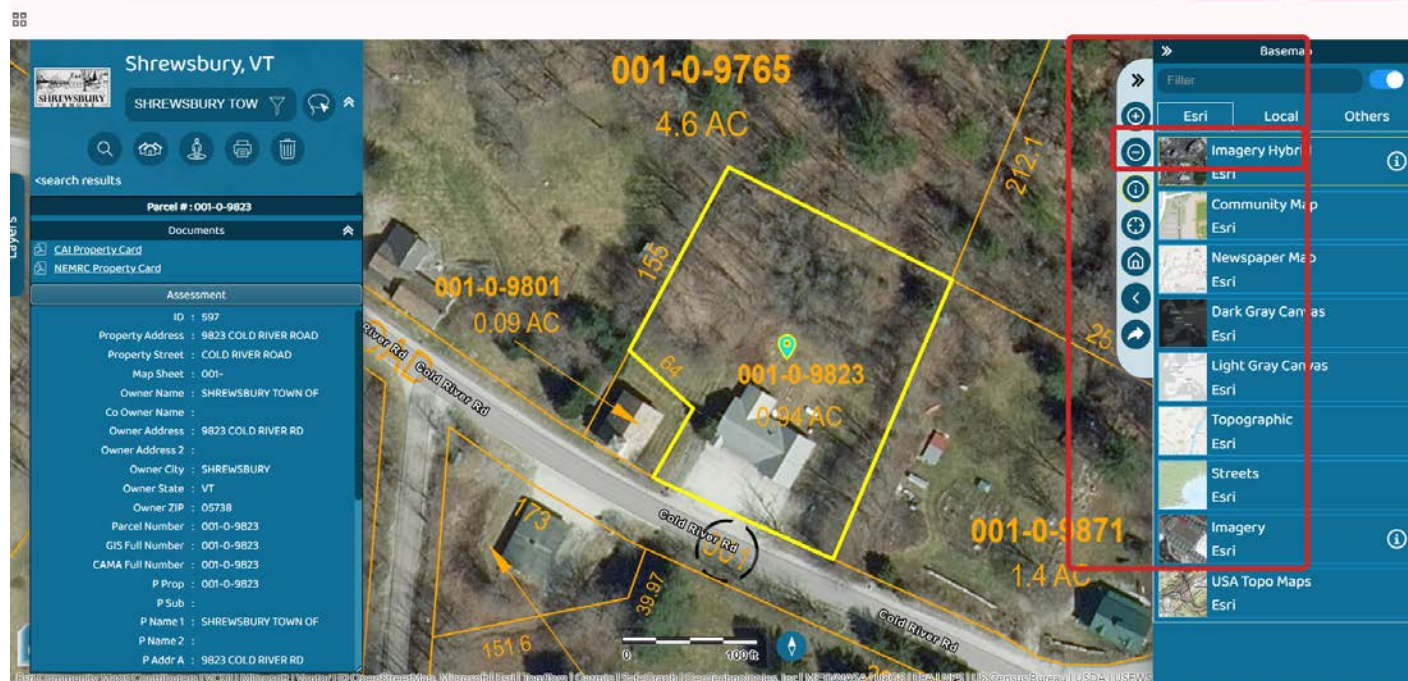


Another Helpful AxisGIS Feature

Change the Map to Aerial Imagery

Open the Basemap menu on the right side of the map and select Imagery Hybrid. This view shows aerial imagery along with property lines, parcel numbers, roads, and other map information.



About the Information You See Online

Property assessment and Grand List information is public information and has been available online for many years. This is the first time Shrewsbury's Property Record Cards have been available online. The aerial imagery shown in AxisGIS is provided as a mapping reference and was not collected as part of Shrewsbury's reappraisal.
